1 Submission of Application Form:

Download the designated application form (Excel format) from the Youth Water Forum video submission page. The group representative (e.g., school teacher) should fill in the required information and submit it to the designated email address stated below by the application deadline.

2 Application Confirmation:

Upon receiving your application form without any discrepancies, we will send an email to the group representative, acknowledging the receipt of your application and providing instructions for video submission. If any discrepancies are found in the application form, we may contact the group representative for clarification.

3 Video Submission:

Submit your video after completing the application process. Please provide a 3-minute video in English and a thumbnail image. Upload them to the online storage platform provided by the secretariat. For details, please refer to the application guidelines and make necessary preparations.
