#### Terms of Reference

#### Welcome to Youth Water Forum 2022

# Concept

Recently, there have been numerous weather-related disasters around the world. Problems caused by events such as heavy rains, major snowfalls, and droughts are worsening day by day.

Water issues are a fundamental part of achieving the SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals). Regional history is a crucial factor in the sustainable management and efficient and reliable delivery of water services, so cross-generational efforts are needed if we are to solve water-related problems.

Therefore, the Youth Water Forum is inviting young people from the Asia-Pacific region to create and submit videos related to water. There is no restriction on the contents of the videos as long as they contain water-related themes, such as the role of water in everyday life, water research, volunteer work, traditional events, or international exchange activities related to water.

# **Applications and Submissions**

- 1. Notes on participation
- 1. Participants must be aged 15 to 18 at the time of application.
- 2. Girls are encouraged to apply.
- 3. Participants may enter as Individuals or in groups
- 4. Each participant or group of participants may submit only one entry or their submission will be disqualified.

# 2. Application period

I June 2022, through 23:59 (JST) on 23 December 2022

## 3. Requirements for Video Submission

The video must meet these requirements:

- 1. The maximum duration of the video is 3 minutes.
- 2. Theme: Related to water.

The Video should showcase young people's ideas, projects, activities, or campaigns which promote sustainable actions related to the water environment.

- 3. The video must be in English or have English subtitles.
- 4. The video must show the following information: video title, name of the group, and the date of creation. The applicants may decide how and when in the video to display this information.
- 5. The video may contain graphics, animation, music, and written text which are universally understood (e.g., a stop sign).
- 6. The video must be submitted as in MOV, WMV, MPG (MPEG), or AVI file formats. The aspect ratio must be 16:9 and the resolution at least  $1280 \times 720$ .
- 7. All materials used in the video must be under free use or open license. If not, the participants shall own the license to use the materials.

Upload a video and a thumbnail image (aspect ratio must be 16:9 and resolution must be at least 1280  $\times$  720) on the online storage. We will send upload instructions to the e-mail address provided in the application.
